THE TENNIS CLUB

Guildwood is one of the top community tennis clubs in Scarborough and is one of the five clubs with four or more courts. It is one of the largest clubs in Scarborough and has a dedicated group of volunteers.

TENNIS LESSONS

The club provides as a service to its members, court time for lessons. Members taking lessons will be taught by a qualified instructor who has been approved by the club's executive. As a special incentive the club will provide lessons for adult beginners during the first two years.

Beginner lessons for Junior members are provided in two one-week sessions in May, at no extra charge, as part of their membership. Additional lessons at reasonable rates are offered in June. Private lessons for all members may also be arranged by contacting the instructor.

THURSDAY "GUILDWOOD CUP" NIGHT

You probably know how Davis Cup works. Various countries field teams of six tennis players who play against the other countries in their division, with top teams advancing to the next tier. This year we have set aside Thursday evenings in June for a month of Guildwood Cup. You will be a member of a team and will play doubles matches against every other team over the course of the event to earn points for your team. This format allows for play at many levels, so it is suitable for all players who have played sets of tennis. Team captains will aim to assign fair match-ups for each game. At the end of the month we will have determined our Guildwood Cup Champions.

Tennis is one of the best sports for kids, family, friends, and life. So GTC is happy to host our first ever Guildwood Day Family Clinic provided by the Ontario Tennis Association Touring program. This will take place on Saturday, June 1st from 1 to 3 p.m. and will include games and drills for Juniors of varying abilities. Parents you are welcome to join in the activities. Pizza and refreshments will be served following the clinic.

The **Corn Roast and Tournament** on September 6th to 8th, is the club's major social event. It is a mixture of fun tennis and a big cook-out and barbecue in the summer. The club tournament runs on Friday night, Sept 6th, Saturday Sept 7th and Sunday Morning the 8th. The Corn roast is on Sunday at Noon.

The **Veterans Round Robin**, will be run on Sept 14th, rain-out date, Sept 15th. This is an activity reserved for adult tennis players 45 years old and over. Refreshments are part of this social event.

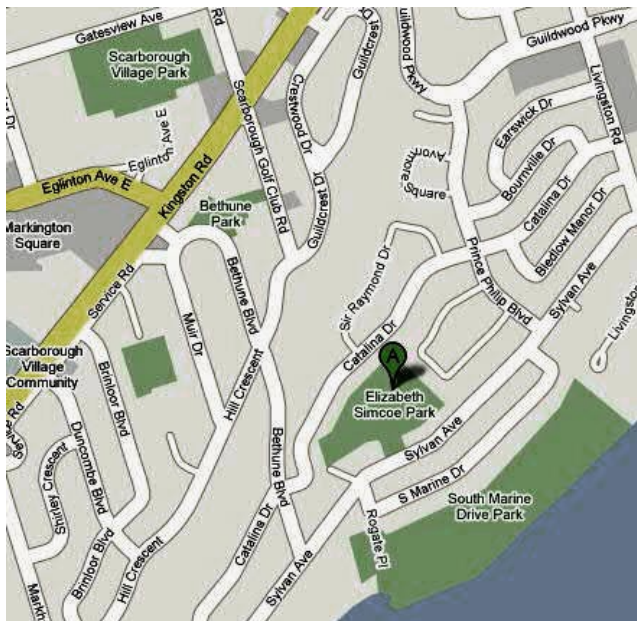
JUNIOR PROGRAMS
